

Liuwa Plain National Park Rates 2016

Current rates for Liuwa Plain National Park are stated in US Dollar for non-Zambian citizens or residents, though rates can be paid both in Zambian Kwacha (ZMW) or US Dollar (US\$). The exchange rate used will be stated for each month at the beginning of the month.

Note

- Passports must be shown upon arrival for verification.
- A Zambian resident is defined as a non-Zambian person that is in possession of a National Registration Card (NRC), and can show it upon arrival in Kalabo. Work permits will not be accepted as proof of residency in Zambia.
- Children rates apply to children that are between 12 to 15 years old at the time of their arrival in Liuwa. All fees are waived for children that are 11 years old and younger.
- Vehicle recovery/towing rates are subject to change, dependant on fuel price increases and the distance from Kalabo.
- Regrettably, we cannot accept credit cards or traveller cheques. All rates include 16% VAT.

Cancellation/Downgrading (reducing the total value)

- 14 days or less prior to arrival (or after arrival) will result in a 100% modification fee
- 15 to 30 days before arrival will result in a 50% modification fee
- 31 to 45 days before arrival will result in a 25% modification fee
- Cancellation is calculated on the total value of the reservation that was cancelled; downgrading is calculated on the difference between the reservation costs before and after the changes were made.
