

All camps are staffed with highly qualified guides, each specialized and experienced in bespoke guiding tailored to our guests' needs and interests, such as photography, birding, walking, etc. Walking safaris are an exception: at all camps except Ntemwa-Busanga, we have only one escort scout on duty. Therefore, two walking safaris cannot be conducted simultaneously. Guests interested in walking safaris will need to join a group (with a maximum of 6 guests per walking safari). Our specialized game viewing vehicles are equipped with just six guest seats. While we aim to have no more than four guests per activity, this number may vary due to unforeseen circumstances. 						
		Children of all ages are welcome when part of a Private Camp/Exclusive Use booking. Children not part of an Exclusive Use booking are still welcome from the age of 14 and upwards and are charged at 50% of the advertised adult rate. FLIGHTS T'S AND C'S

DEPARTURE TIMES

Final departure times will only be confirmed during the week before any flight.

International flight details and prior and post travel and accommodation arrangements are essential for planning flight times. Passengers must be ready for collection from Airports (Lusaka and Livingstone) at least 45 minutes prior to departure. Passengers must be ready for collection from Airstrips at least 30 minutes prior to departure. Whilst all routings aim to be direct from point A to B, CZ reserves the right to route within reason via nearby strips for refuelling or drop/collection of other pax.

LUGGAGE

Restricted to a maximum of 15kg per person hold luggage, plus hand luggage and/or camera equipment not exceeding 5kg. Luggage in SOFT bags only will be accepted, no rigid frames or wheels. Excess baggage can be arranged with a cost subject to availability and by prior approval.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Every effort will be made to hold these rates throughout 2024 and 2025, however should fuel/landing etc prices rise by more than 10% they may have to be revised for value.

Name changes are permitted as are timing adjustments subject to availability.

From time to time light aircraft may not be able to safely fly due to inclement weather, in particular during the start of the rainy season in late October/early November. This could result in clients having to overnight in Lusaka or elsewhere. In this instance our reservations team will organize the most suitable accommodation. Clients will be expected to pay for this and trust that their travel insurance will cover such incidents.

The guest/travel agent/tour operator should advise the Company in the event that a passenger weighs over 85kg at the time of requesting a quotation, as well as at time of confirming the booking, as it may be necessary to cost in an additional seat on internal flights for the passenger's safety and comfort.

Guests arriving in Zambia, who have not adhered to the luggage guidelines as per above, will NOT be able to depart on the scheduled charter. Regulations are very strict with regards to flight plans; departure timing and aircraft load sheets that have to be logged according to a prescribed timeline for each and every scheduled departure.
